

AIR CONDITIONER CHARGE POLICY

It is the policy of the Algonac Housing Commission to charge residents who install an air conditioner in the window of their respective apartment. Charges are itemized below and are subject to change with approval of the Housing Commission.

Residents who want air conditioning are responsible for purchasing their own air conditioner. The resident is responsible for the installation and removal of the air conditioner. The resident **must** advise the office of the dates of installation and removal.

The monthly charge for air conditioning is set at \$20. This charge can be added to the rent for the unit.

If a resident decides to install or remove an air conditioner unit in the middle of a month the charge is \$5 per week. This weekly charge starts on Sunday and ends on the following Saturday. **IF THE A/C UNIT IS IN THE WINDOW FOR ANY ONE DAY OF THIS SUNDAY TO SATURDAY WEEK THE CHARGE WILL BE \$5.** If, for example, you put the a/c in on Saturday and remove it Monday, the charge will be \$10.

The Housing Commission can store the A/C unit during the winter months. The Resident is responsible to remove the unit and put it in the hallway. The office must be advised when the unit is put into the hallway.
